- Preview our exhibitions to find out which exhibitions are best for your family.
- Talk about the rules of a museum with your family. Please explain that artworks cannot be touched as oil and dirt from fingers can damage the objects.
- Decide if you would like to schedule a guided tour at no extra charge. Or check out our Kids & Family Programs to see if there is an activity that you would like to attend.

### AT BAM

- Find a museum docent to answer any questions and discuss the exhibitions with your family (weekdays 1 - 3pm, weekends 12 - 4pm).
- Food and drinks are not permitted in the galleries. Please finish enjoying your snacks on the first floor before heading upstairs.
- To ensure better mobility, strollers are best left on the ground floor, but are not prohibited in the galleries.
- Restrooms are located on every floor of the Museum and each restroom has a changing table inside.
- Pick up an Activity Guide, filled with quizzes and projects related to a particular exhibition.
- If you plan to write or draw while in the galleries, please use pencil only.
- Take a program brochure home with you so you can plan your next visit.
- Our parking garage closes 30 minutes after the Museum closes. Please plan accordingly.
